

Key Stage 2 results 2017

In 2017 there were 90 children eligible to take the key stage 2 SATs, 86 pupils were entered to take the tests. The results are:

Progress measures for 2017 are the same as last year where many schools will now have a negative figure. To be above national expectations (FLOOR TARGET) schools need to have a progress score better than (nearer to zero) -5 in reading and writing and -7 in mathematics.
