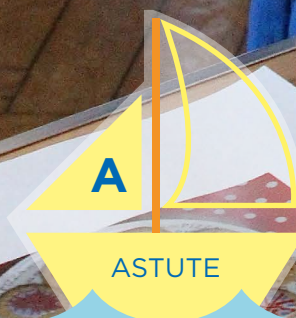

Beyond the School Day...

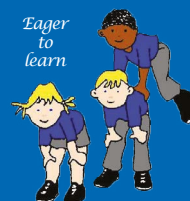
Leapfrog Breakfast and After School club was formed in September 1998 and has always prided itself in providing an outstanding service.
