In this topic we are going to be learning the necessary skills to help us cook delicious recipes based on some of Roald Dahl's best loved characters.

We will be:

- Learning how to tell the time to the nearest five minutes to help us time our recipes.
- Remembering the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
- Comparing and sequencing intervals of time.
- Learning how to measure mass in grams and kilograms and read scales on weighing scales.
- Learning how to read the temperature in degrees (°C) from a thermometer and plan how hot our oven needs to be!
- Learning how to measure capacity using measuring jugs in millilitres and litres (ml/l) in case we need to use any liquids!
- Measuring length in centimetres (cm) using a ruler.
- Comparing and ordering these measures using the symbols $>$, $<$ and $=$.

Along with lots of other fun activities throughout the half term!



English

In English we will be learning all about Traditional Tales and writing our own versions of some of the classics!

- Revising our use of capital letters and full stops to show sentence boundaries.
- Learning how to write longer sentences using the conjunctions, when, if, that and because.
- Using direct speech to make our writing more effective.
