

British Sign Language Lessons/Signed supported English

The Sensory Impaired Resource has its own communicator, who teaches hearing impaired children British Sign Language, this is on-going in the classroom as well as timetabled lessons delivered within the Resource.

Sign supported English is used during Literacy and again lessons are delivered in the resource. Each small word within the English language has a sign, for example a, to, too, the, as, etc.

The Sensory Impaired Resource also runs a Sign Language Club for all the pupils interested in learning Sign.
