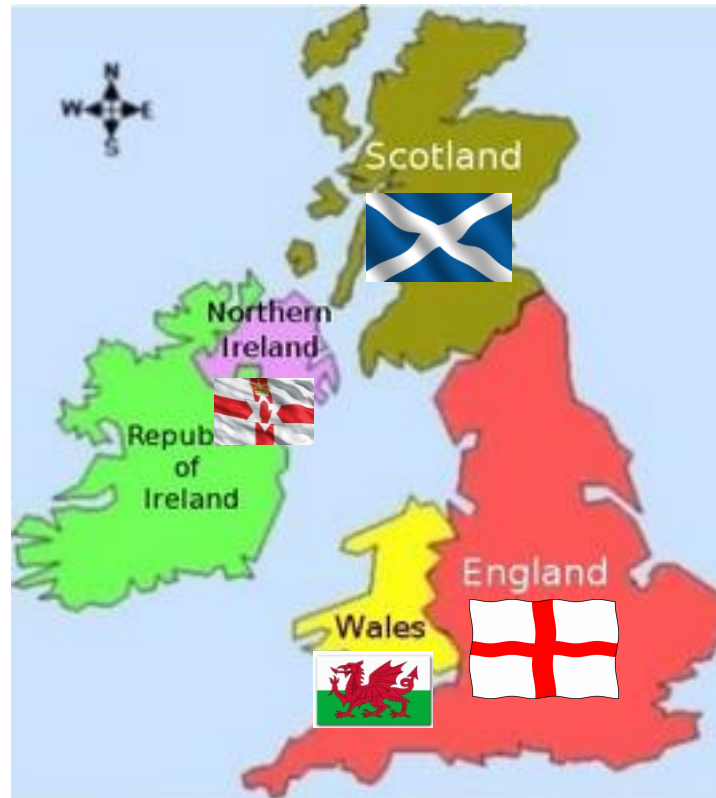

What happens in Parliament?

Parliament is where politicians meet to make laws, debate topical issues and look at how our taxes are spent to help run the country. One of the jobs Parliament does is to check that the Government is running the country properly.

Who gets to work in Parliament?

We live in a democratic country, which means we all have a say in how the country is run. We do this by electing Members of Parliament (MPs) to represent our views in the House of Commons. The Monarch, our Queen, signs the laws that Parliament votes for.

The Government

The Government runs the country and is also elected by the people.

The leader of the Government is called the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister lives at 10 Downing Street, London.
