Choose a location that you have visited on holiday OR your dream holiday location! Design a poster or a leaflet to advertise and attract holiday makers to that destination.

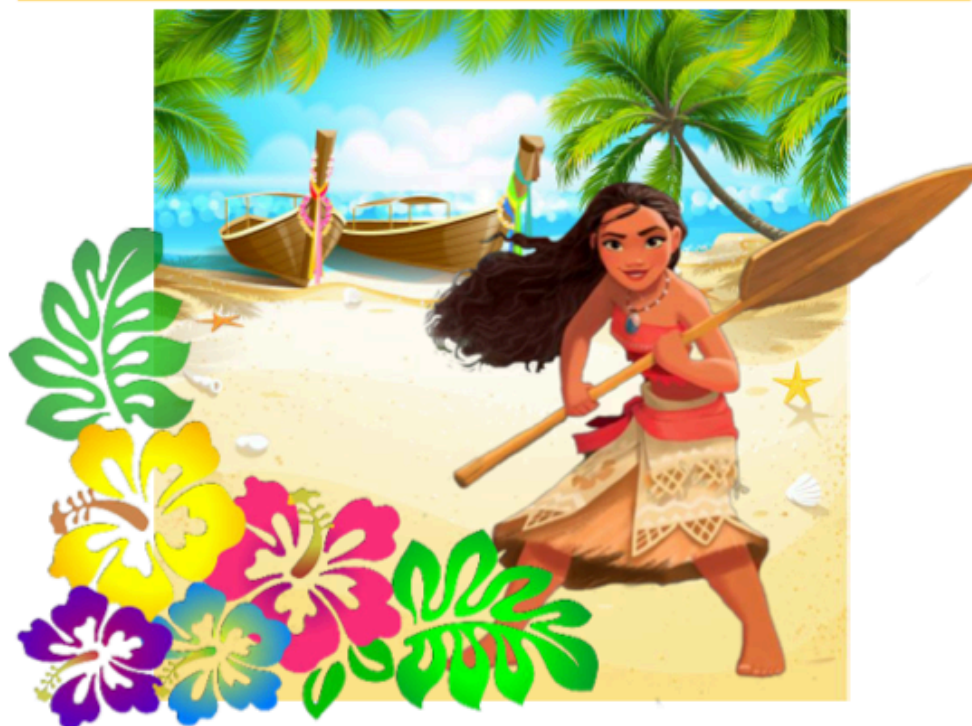
