Year 4 Spring Term 2022.


During the first half term of the Spring Term, Year 4 will be learning about Extreme earth.

Reading: We will start by looking at our new text My Pebble in my pocket. We will be looking at improving out reading skills by us-


ing retrieval, inference and looking at how to find out meanings of unknown words.
