Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from the success of 'Give a Kid a Quid' in previous years and the 'Class Enterprise Challenge', we are launching two further business challenges for classes and individuals to work on between now and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June. The challenges are:

**Group Challenge** – Each class is given £5 start-up funds. They need to work as a team with their teacher to come up with a business idea to then produce a product or service that can be sold at the Summer Fayre.

Individual/family Challenge – Each child is given a £1 start-up and takes this home to then work with their family to develop their own business idea to make a profit on their pound. Some ideas may involve doing something before the Summer Fayre (Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May) to sell- please indicate on the slip below if they will want a stall.

Otherwise, they might like to grow their pound outside of school, for example by washing cars and buying the things needed to do this with the £1. In order for the child to be given £1, the reply slip below must be completed by a parent and returned to school. The child will then bring the start-up £1 home.

The hope is that all funds invested will make a profit. Any profit made will be used to invest in future events for our children and families. Profits should be returned by **Friday 7**<sup>th</sup> **June** (any money made at the summer fayre will be collected on the day).
