Sports Premium Funding Statement What is the Sports Premium?

The government has provided funding of £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15 to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. For 2018-19 each school will receive £16,000 plus an extra £10 per pupil. At Northern Parade Infant & Junior Schools that will mean around £19600 (Infant) & £20720 (Junior) a year. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Purpose of the funding

All schools have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but there is freedom to choose how we do it.

At Northern Parade Infant & Junior Schools we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. In addition, we believe that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children.

Use of funding at Northern Parade Infant & Junior Schools

The money will be used so that all children benefit regardless of sporting ability. We will continue to place a high priority on our P.E. provision and, as such, have invested in additional personnel, resources and training to further enhance P.E. in the curriculum, extracurricular times and lunchtimes.

For the next academic year, we intend to continue our involvement with Priory support programme, training and resources for Staff CPD where appropriate. We will continue to offer a range of clubs, teams and sports to include trampoline, gym, netball, cheer leading and girls football. Ensure Pupil Premium children have equal access to after school clubs. We will continue provide PE kits provided for children where needed. Maintain mini buses to ensure participating children can attend after school venues and that children can experience greater amounts of offsite experiences to enrich physical curriculum.
