

Ages Ago

English: We will be learning about instructional texts and will create our own using the example of 'How to wash a woolly mammoth'. We will also be learning to use dictionaries effectively to identify the meaning of new words to help widen our vocabulary.



Maths: This half term we will focus heavily on place value and the children will be exploring three-digit numbers using a wide variety of resources and exciting activities. We will also try drawing life size pictures relating to our topic (using scales) and ordering numbers, such as dates in chronological order.

Science: Mrs Creasey will be teaching Year 3 about the properties of materials, solids, liquids and gases, reversible and irreversible changes and comparing rocks/soils/fossils.

History: We will find out about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and how these changes have influenced the way we live today.

Geography: We will investigate human geography, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activities (trade links), and the distribution of natural resources (energy, food, minerals, water).



DT: The children will be designing, making and evaluating houses or tools from the Stone Age period.

Art: The children will create their own cave paintings, drawings and sculptures using different materials and techniques.

PSHE: "Me and My Feelings" will be our PSHE topic for Autumn 1 and will involve discussions around managing feelings surrounding new people, seeing things from someone else's perspective and the qualities of a good friendship.

R.E: The children will be thinking about what it means to belong to a group and will relate this to their learning about the Christian faith, with a focus on baptism.

ICT: Children will be using a range of different presentational software programmes and ICT to research the Stone Age ready for our museum.

PE: Outdoor sports will focus on team games.

Music / Dance: We will be rehearsing for our Lower School Production.

Spanish: A basic introduction to Spain and the language.
