<u>Year 3</u> Walk Like An Egyptian <u>Spring 1 - 2020</u>

<u>English</u>: We will be exploring diary entries, starting with Howard Carter's diary entry after discovering the tomb of Tutankhamun. We will then have a go at writing our own diary entries.

<u>Maths:</u> Through various problem-solving activities, we will learn about working systematically and then apply this to our work on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

<u>Science</u>: We will be looking at the human body and identifying parts of the skeleton and different muscles and organs.
