Staff Retention



Recruitment and retention of staff is becoming a significant issue in schools and KANP is no exception. The results from the second wave of the DfE's working lives of teachers and leaders survey, have been released.

Just over one-third of teachers and leaders (36%) indicated that they were considering leaving the state school sector in the next 12 months, excluding for retirement.

This represents an increase from 25% in 2022. We have lost far too many excellent colleagues over the years who are no longer in education. Please look after your schools and their staff and don't take what we do for granted.

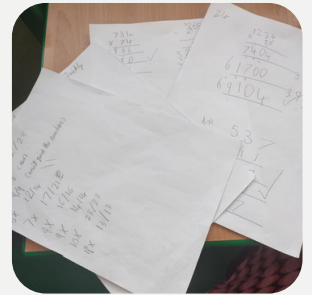
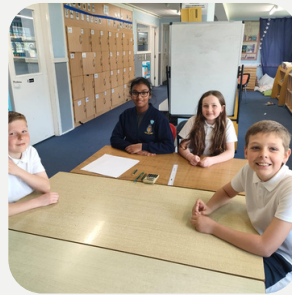
Challenge
