What will I need to do as a parent/carer on the day?

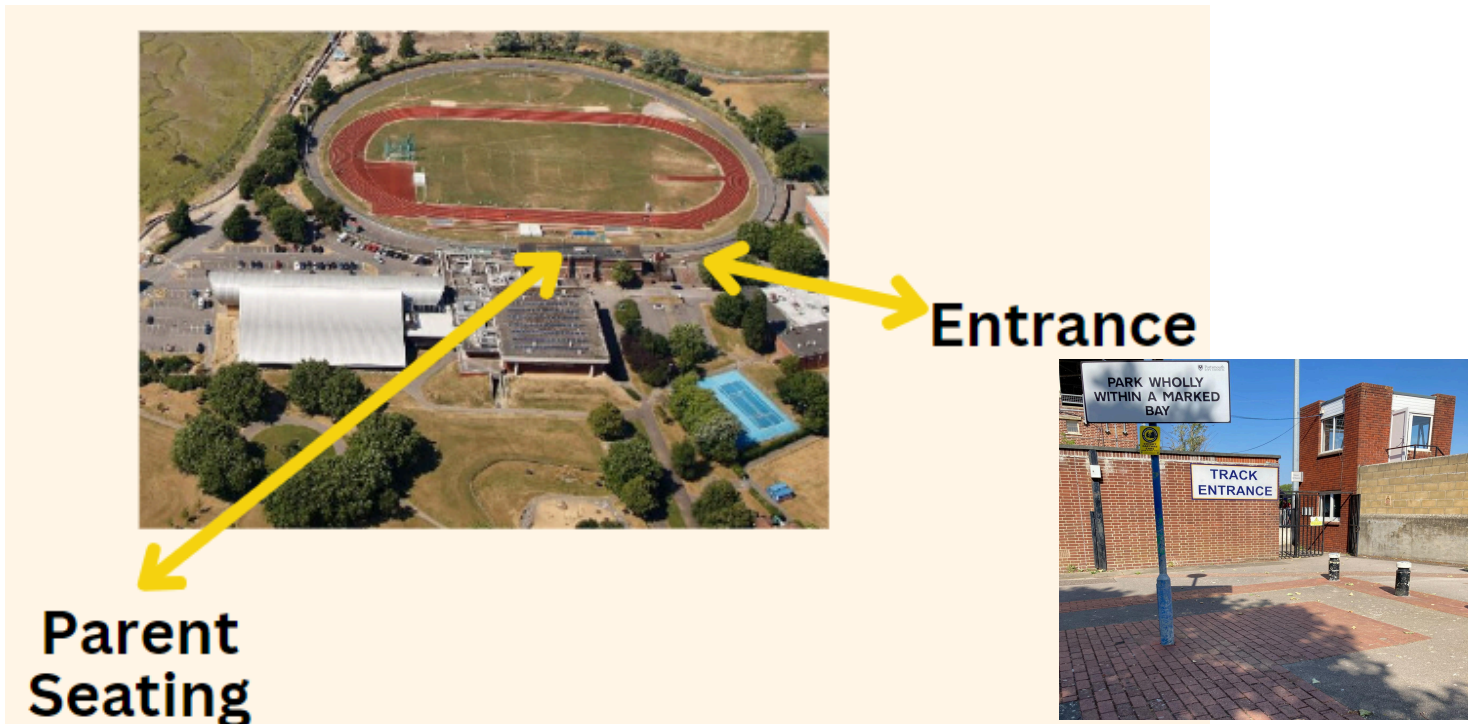
- Make your way to the Mountbatten centre for **10:15am**
