Spelling and Phonics

Year 6 will continue the phonics and spelling work from last term. Interventions and booster groups to help improve spelling and phonics for those who need additional help, will also continue.

We will use our daily spelling lessons to practice the statutory spellings for Year 3 and 4 as well as Year 5 and 6.

Children will be encouraged to integrate their spelling knowledge into their writing lessons to ensure they use a wide vocabulary and apply this to their learning.

Shared Reading

In Shared Reading this term we will be looking at the book Letters From the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll by focusing all of the previously taught reading skills so that we can fully understand the text. Alongside this we will also be focusing on a variety of other texts in preparation for the upcoming SATs.

English

In English, we will be focusing on a new fiction book called 'The Island' which explores issues around racism and social politics. We will consider the viewpoints of different characters in the book and use these to help us write persuasive letters containing persuasive devices. We will also continue to practice our GPaS knowledge in preparation for the

Matha

In Maths, we have begun our revision and have been problem solving fraction problems. We will then be moving on to revising measurement and scales multi-step problems. As well as this, we have been practicing our arithmetic daily ready for our SAT's.

PE/Music

PE days are Tuesday and Thursday for Valiant and Invincible classes whilst for Daring and Courageous, it is Tuesdays and Fridays.

Science

In Science this term, we are going to continue exploring our previous unit of Light before moving onto our new topic, which will be electricity. During the electricity unit, we will explore simple circuits, their function and understand the developments which have been made in this area.
