Spelling and Phonics

This half term we are continuing the Essential Letters and Sounds phonics programme to prepare us for our phonics screening test. Each week pupils will be given a set of spellings to practice at home related to the learning in class. We will also be learning to read our 'harder to read and spell' words.

English - Reading and Writing

Our Writing this half term is focusing on instructional writing. We are learning about the features and how to write a simple set of instructions. We will be moving onto Non-Fiction texts towards the end of the term.

In Reading we are using our own background knowledge to make simple predictions and understand how characters are feeling. Our texts this term focus on the theme of growing and living.

Maths

This half term in Maths we will be learning about one more and one less. We are solving missing number problems and exploring how numbers are made using tens and ones. We are going to keep working with our rekenreks to learn about the number system.

PE & Art

In PE we will be learning the skills related to athletics and how to travel in different ways. We will also be learning our sponsored 'Dance for Diabetes' moves.

In Art we are experimenting with pencil lines and drawing real life items.

Science/Computing

In Science we will be exploring the properties of materials and their suitability to make different items. In computing we are understanding the importance of online safety and using direction to program an item.

RE & PSHE

In RE, we will be learning about the preciousness of water and how Christians and Hindus use water in ceremonies. In PSHE we are recognising the importance of staying healthy, having good hygiene routines and using strategies when we find something difficult.

Geography

In Geography we will be using fieldwork skills to read maps of our local area. We will be exploring how to use globes, atlases and how to read a key. The children will learn basic compass directions for map navigation.
