### Year 2 to Year 3 Transition Information 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

As this academic year comes towards an end, I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the transition plans for children starting at King's Academy Northern Parade Junior School in Year 3 in September 2024. The following outlines the activities/events that will take place over the next few weeks. The purpose of which is to ensure that the transition from the infant to the junior school is as smooth as possible.

Date	Activity	Summary
Tuesday 18 <sup>th</sup> June	Year 2 visit to the Junior School	The Year 2 children will visit the Junior school to meet their new transition buddies. They will spend the session taking part in a range of art activities and they will experience break time on the Junior School playground. <b><i>As a parent/carer there is no need to do anything for this.</i></b>
Friday 28th June	Transition meeting for teachers. INSET day	Teachers from Year 2 and Year 3 will meet to discuss the children's academic achievement and social and emotional needs. <b><i>As a parent/carer there is no need to do anything for this.</i></b>
Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd July	Transition days with new class teachers	Year 2 children will visit the Junior school and spend the day with their new Year 3 teachers. Children will be brought over to the Junior school by their current class teachers after morning registration. <b><i>As a parent/carer there is no need to do anything for this.</i></b>
Monday 8th July	Parent information evening	The presentation evening will be run by staff from the Junior School. Information will include: an introduction to staff, what to do in the first week in September, school expectations and timetables and how you can support your child. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions. <b><i>Parents/carers are invited to attend the meeting in the Junior school hall at either 3:30pm or 5:00pm (further information to follow)</i></b>
Tuesday 9 <sup>th</sup> July and Wednesday 10 <sup>th</sup> July	Lunch at the Junior School	Year 2 children will visit the Junior school over lunch time and eat with their transition buddies. Children will be brought over to the Junior school by their current class teachers. <b><i>As a parent/carer there is no need to do anything for this.</i></b>
Monday 15 <sup>th</sup> July	Year 2 visit to the Junior School for a sports and reading afternoon	Year 2 children will visit the Junior School to take part in a sports afternoon. They will work alongside their transition buddies during this time. <b><i>For this event parents and carers are invited to come and work alongside your child for the afternoon. The event will begin at</i></b>

Thursday 18 <sup>th</sup> July	Year 3 teachers to visit the Year 2 children in class	The Year 3 teachers will visit the children at the Infant school to observe them in class and spend time getting to know them. They will teach a joint lesson with the children's current teachers. <b><i>As a parent/carer there is no need to do anything for this.</i></b>

We recognise that some children may require additional support with their transition process. I would like to reassure you that should this be the case, additional transition sessions and activities will be put in place.

We are looking forward to continuing to work with you all. If you are unable to attend the presentation evening, the information will be available after the event on our school website.
