




Writing

Let's spark the imagination of our young writers from inventors and engineers to creators of magic. Children will be inspired through STEM-themed stories such as *Rosie Revere, Engineer*, *The Girl and the Robot* on Literacy Shed, and *The Square Root of Possible*, encouraging creativity, problem-solving, and a love of science and invention.



Reading

This half term, we will ignite a love of reading by exploring imaginative and thought-provoking stories that inspire curiosity and empathy. Children will enjoy a mix of classic tales, modern adventures, and Literacy Shed short films, developing comprehension, vocabulary, and a lifelong passion for stories.

Maths

In Maths we are recapping our 21 times table facts that we learnt in year 3 and moving on to our 3x tables in preparation for the MTC. We are also working on our place value knowledge, exploring, ordering, comparing and building numbers to 10,000.

Science

In Year 4, children explore electricity, learning how it is generated, conducted, and used safely in everyday life. They investigate circuits, conductors, and insulators, and develop their scientific skills through hands-on experiments and problem-solving activities.

History

We will be studying the Celts and their way of life, giving children opportunities to explore both primary and secondary sources. Through hands-on activities and investigations, they will develop an understanding of Celtic culture, society, and daily life.

DT

In DT, children will focus on designing and making their own torches, exploring a range of electrical circuits to ensure their creations suit their purpose and design. They will develop practical skills, problem-solving, and an understanding of how circuits work in real-life applications.
