Remote Learning at King's Academy Northern Parade

At King's Academy Northern Parade, we are committed to ensuring that all pupils can continue learning at home, whether during **weekends, periods of self-isolation, or whole-school closures**.

Our Remote Learning Offer

Our approach: - Keeps pupils' learning on track and minimises disruption - Uses **Google Classroom** for lessons and activities during closures - Supports **school-home engagement** while following safeguarding procedures - Removes barriers to learning at home wherever possible - Helps pupils complete work to the **best of their ability** - Supports pupils' **social, emotional, and mental health needs**

How We Provide Learning

Whole School Closure: - Pupils continue to use their **regular Google Classroom** for live lessons and tasks. - Longer closures include **online curriculum, assemblies, and Google Meet sessions**.

Self-Isolation: - Pupils isolating due to illness or guidance use a **dedicated self-isolation Google Classroom**. - Features a **weekly timetable**, links to teaching resources, and optional enrichment activities. - Access is **restricted to self-isolating pupils**, who receive an invitation via email or through Google Classroom.

Online Learning Platforms: To support learning at home, we also use: - **TT Rockstars** – for times tables practice and fluency - **Numbots** – for developing mental maths skills - **Oxford Reading Owl** – for reading practice and comprehension

Support and Access: - **Google Classroom Quick Start Guides** help pupils navigate the platform. - If a pupil does **not have access to a device or internet**, parents should contact the school to arrange alternatives.

Parent/Carer Responsibilities

We ask that parents/carers: - Monitor attendance and engagement as per school policy - Ensure pupils can access learning and complete tasks to the best of their ability - Support attendance at live lessons, with pupils in **school uniform** - Follow the home-school agreement and online learning protocols - Report technical issues promptly

Pupil Responsibilities

We ask that pupils: - Complete learning tasks to the best of their ability - Notify an adult if they cannot access learning materials - Attend live lessons in **school uniform** during closures - Follow the school **behaviour policy** and **online learning protocols**

Together, we ensure that learning continues safely and effectively, even when pupils are at home.
